New Accommodation Lets Guests Live Modern Fairy Tale

EVERGREEN, Colo.—Travelers looking for the ultimate combination of luxury, romance and nature will be able to stay in the Highland Haven Creekside Inn’s newly completed Tree House suite starting May 1st. Created with love by owners Gail Riley and Tom Statzell, the 850-square-foot, Tree House is magical, one-of-a-kind getaway built atop 21-foot-high, 36-inch-diameter cedar log structures. Features of the above-ground main level include:

- Stairways lined with rare collection of tree house art
- Wet bar with teak root sink, LED glass shelf lighting and quartzite stone tile work
- Antique stained glass reclaimed from Denver mansion
- Custom tile and iron fireplace
- Bathroom featuring petrified wood vanity sink and charming pebble path leading to steam shower

A climb to the second story reveals a dreamy spa cupola anchored by an infinity-edged Jacuzzi with “champagne” micro-bubble technology. From the tub, guests can enjoy the multi-colored, stained-stick paneling on the 15-foot peaked ceiling, along with an enchanting aspen mobile created by a Colorado artist. Sixty-five yards of caramel sheers and unspoiled views of towering pine trees complete the scene.
